

PRIVACY POLICY

Allied Physicians IPA is committed to protect your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Allied Physicians IPA web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the Allied Physicians IPA website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Allied Physicians IPA may collect personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Allied Physicians IPA also may collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Allied Physicians IPA This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring web site addresses. This information is used by Allied Physicians IPA for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Allied Physicians IPA web site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Allied Physicians IPA public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: Allied Physicians IPA does not responsible for any of your private online communications.

Allied Physicians IPA encourages you to review the privacy statements of web sites you choose to link to from Allied Physicians IPA so that you can understand how those web sites collect, use and share your information. Allied Physicians IPA is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on web sites outside of the Allied Physicians IPA and Allied Physicians IPA family of web sites.

Use of your Personal Information

Allied Physicians IPA collects and uses your personal information to operate the Allied Physicians IPA web site and deliver the services you have requested. Allied Physicians IPA also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Allied Physicians IPA and its affiliates. Allied Physicians IPA may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Allied Physicians IPA does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Allied Physicians IPA may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name,

address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Allied Physicians IPA may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Allied Physicians IPA, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Allied Physicians IPA does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Allied Physicians IPA keeps track of the web sites and pages our users visit within Allied Physicians IPA, in order to determine what Allied Physicians IPA services are meeting their needs. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Allied Physicians IPA to users whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Allied Physicians IPA web sites will not disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Allied Physicians IPA or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Allied Physicians IPA; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Allied Physicians IPA, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Allied Physicians IPA web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Allied Physicians IPA pages, or register with Allied Physicians IPA site or services, a cookie helps Allied Physicians IPA to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Allied Physicians IPA web site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Allied Physicians IPA features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Allied Physicians IPA services or web sites you visit.

Security of Your Personal Information

Allied Physicians IPA secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Allied Physicians IPA secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, physically secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. It is also protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

Changes to this Statement

Allied Physicians IPA will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. Allied Physicians IPA encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how Allied Physicians IPA is protecting your information.
